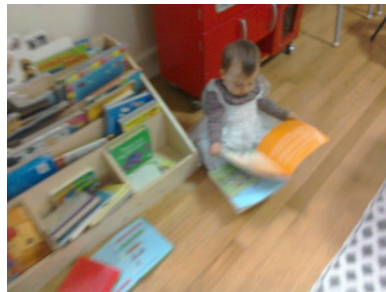
## Last week...
